Here is what you should bring to the meeting:

#### Supply List for July Wonky Star Project:

Cream colored fabric, 1/4 yard or one fat quarter

Portable sewing machine with blue and cream colored threads

Cutting mat with rotary cutter

Ruler, pins, scissors, portable iron and ironing board

Power strip or Extension cord

Some of us are bringing 2 machines and irons so don't worry if you don't have or can't carry yours to the meeting, we will have plenty to use.

Our August program will be presented by our own member, Kathy Haver.

For the September program we will need our sewing machines again because we will be making fleece hats and baby car jackets to be donated for cancer patients.

We will also need a meeting place starting again in September. If you know of a church or community center that will let us meet once a month for free or a nominal fee, please let me know.

We will also have kits available to be sewn for charity quilts. Some will be for children and some for adults. These will be available to sign out by members -- allowing for two months to sew and return just the top done or the whole quilt done.
